

Reflection | A Story Experience on the Drown-Proofing Orientation

On 15 February 2025, from 0600H to 1100H, we gathered at the Nuevavila Pool for our Drown-Proofing Orientation, a crucial activity designed to enhance our swimming skills and water safety awareness. Learning how to swim is essential, not only as a basic life skill but also as a means to prevent drowning and ensure personal safety in and around water. With this in mind, all participants eagerly prepared for a series of interactive activities.

We began with proper pool entry and exit procedures, emphasizing the importance of safety even before stepping into the water. This fundamental skill set the stage for the rest of the training.

Next, we practiced blowing bubbles underwater, a simple yet enjoyable drill that helps individuals acclimate to submersion and breath control. Encouragement and smiles filled the pool as everyone engaged in this essential technique.

The session progressed with floating and gliding exercises, where participants learned how to stay afloat and conserve energy while swimming. This activity was crucial in building water confidence and reinforcing the importance of staying calm in deep water.

One of the highlights of the day was the swimming vest drill. Participants learned how to properly wear a life vest by simulating an emergency scenario—floating and then swimming towards the vest. This hands-on experience strengthened their ability to use safety equipment effectively and confidently.

As a symbol of teamwork, we performed a circle float, holding hands and floating together for 15 minutes. This exercise not only improved our floating endurance but also fostered a sense of camaraderie among the participants.

By the end of the session, it was clear that the experience had been both challenging and rewarding. Everyone walked away with new skills and greater confidence, proving that growth comes from stepping beyond one's fears.

Finally, we reinforced a valuable lesson: learning begins with taking the first step. Overcoming fear is essential for progress, and embracing challenges leads to personal development. A heartfelt thank you to everyone who participated and contributed to the success of this orientation!

Annika is a past Titleholder as Miss Montana's Teen in 2020-21 for the Miss America Organization. Annika is family to Captain Mervyn S. Bennion, killed in action during the

Japanese attack on Pearl Harbor in 1941. He was honored by the United States Navy naming a Fletcher-class destroyer, the USS Bennion (DD-662), that participated in decimating the Japanese Task Force in the Battle of Surigao Strait, Philippines in 1944 leading to defeat of Imperial Japan.


Annika is the founder of No NicoTeen America: education and advocacy for nicotine-free teens. With over 16 million views, her campaign has reached youth in every U.S. state.




